The celebration of the African Child Day because the topics that are developed are important for us.

What is the challenge you want to take up in the short term? Why?

To complete my training because it will be profitable for me.

Who do you like helping the most? Your parents/caretakers or friends? Why?

My father because he supports me in my tasks.

The family still makes a living from agriculture and breeding. This year:

- The mother still sells fruits in the market.
- The father of Salif continues helping people trade or buy animals and he earns money from this activity to supplement the farming income.

## The village and the commune

As a sponsor you are part of a joint effort to improve living conditions for children. The effort takes place among all sponsors in the same area as you, and serves to give children the support they need to be able to grow up as healthy and resourceful adults.

During the past year BØRNEfonden carried out many activities. We would like to mention:

- With the Birth Certificate Project, campaigns were held to talk about the importance of having birth
  certificates. On this occasion, a lot of children were also happy to get their birth certificates established.
  Parents are now aware of this importance of that paper and they have promised not to neglect it in the future.
  In the past, a lot of children and even adults did not have their birth certificates and this made their enrolment
  in school and access to other services very difficult.
- With the support of the Early Childhood Development Project, sessions were held to educate and raise
  awareness of parents and mostly mothers about nutritional issues. Parents are now more involved in the
  nutritional follow-up of their children and the heath of their children is improved.
